Play Mary's Tuscany Village Recycled Play Structure is a modestly sized, multi-floor playground unit that packs a lot of fun into a smaller footprint. As a result of the large amount of recycled plastic it incorporates into its materials, this commercial-grade playscape is ecologically friendly. The product's name derives from the beautiful coastal region of central Italy, and this area's magnificent cliffside features are replicated in the vivid photo panels incorporated into the body of the playscape. The architecture's vertical arrangement mirrors the landscape's hilly geography, giving youngsters the chance to build their muscles through achievable climbing challenges like those presented by the metal rungs of the Double Loop Climber or the Rock Wall Climber with its generous number of hand grips. Other kids can make their way up into the structure by way of the gentler ascent of the ADA Transfer Triple Stepper. Once topside, there are two different slides to pick from and some amusing interactions like brightly colored Gear Panels to puzzle over.
